

KNMV Basic Sports Licence

What is a KNMV Basic Sports Licence?

The KNMV Basic Sports Licence is a licence with which you can take part in free training, club and/or district race meetings that fall under the regulations of the KNMV during a calendar year and for an affordable price. With a KNMV Basic Sports Licence, you will receive personal accident and liability insurance as standard, so you can participate in sports responsibly. You also have the option to take out supplementary insurance.

How much does a KNMV Basic Sports Licence cost?

The price of a KNMV Basic Sports Licence 2018 is € 60.00.

KNMV Basic Sports Licence or National licence?

With a KNMV Basic Sports Licence, you can take part in free training, club and/or district race meetings taking part under the regulations of the KNMV.

With a KNMV *National* licence, you can therefore take part in *national* competitions. A national licence *includes* a district licence. However, with a national licence you *cannot* take part in so-called DMX (= district competition) meetings.

Is my KNMV Basic Sports Licence also valid abroad?

No, a KNMV Basic Sports Licence is only valid in the Netherlands. If you will be riding abroad, you are no longer insured through the KNMV Basis Sports Licence. You can take out supplementary insurance. If you do not have Dutch nationality and/or are not a resident of the Netherlands, you cannot enter into additional cover for personal accidents. Liability insurance abroad should be arranged via the club where you will be training, this is not possible from the Netherlands. During the application procedure for the KNMV Basic Sports Licence, you will automatically receive more information about the supplementary insurance options.

From what age can I get a district licence?

The minimum age of an applicant is five years old. The minimum age is six years for minibikes.

I live abroad and I would like to have a KNMV Basic Sports Licence. Is that possible?

Yes, it is. There is one restriction. For non-Dutch residents, the Personal Injury cover under the KNMV Basis Sport Licence is not applicable. In this case, only the liability insurance applies.
